Proposal for Secure Tablets

Ted Lechner Youth Services Center

NCIC Correctional Services is pleased to present our proposal for secure educational tablets for the Ted Lechner Youth Services Center and Shelter Care facility This high-level, preliminary proposal is designed to outline NCIC's capabilities relating to handheld tablets offering an array of positive resources and tools for Youths, as well as secure communications offerings.

Proposed Pricing:

Option 1 – No Cost to Yellowstone County

NCIC will provide up to forty (40) secure tablets with a range of functions, including the Schoolhouse Learning Management System and Entertainment suite, at no cost to Yellowstone County. The Communications offerings (phone calling, video visitation and messaging) will be billable to the users (Youths and / or their approved contacts). This Option assumes that Yellowstone County is not seeking a revenue-share on communications services (in favor of the lowest possible rates for the users):

Costs for Communications:

- o \$0.08/ Minute for all calls in the United States
- o \$0.15/Minute for all International calls
- o \$0.15/Minute for (Remote) Video Visitation
- o \$0.10 per Message
- o \$0.15 per Picture Message



Option 2 – No Cost to Youths and their Families

This option comes at a low monthly cost billed to Yellowstone County; there would be <u>no cost</u> to Youths or their outside approved contacts for any of the available communications services (phone calls, video visits, messaging).

• Secure Handheld Tablets: Flat fee of \$50.00 per Tablet, per Month (\$2,000.00/Month for 40 Tablets|)

Under both of the above Options, the following services and applications will available on the proposed Tablet solution (customizable based on the preferences of Facility administration):

- ✓ Staff-to-Detainee communications
- ✓ Secure phone calling, video visitation and messaging with approved contacts
- ✓ Mail Scanning (digital delivery of physical incoming mail)
- ✓ Digital Document Signing
- ✓ Approved entertainment content (movies, music, games)
- ✓ Religious content (accommodates all commonly known believe systems)
- ✓ Secure, locked-down network infrastructure
