— CERTIFICATE AND DEDICATION —

This is to certify that Earle E. Tiffany and Helen A. Tiffany, his wife, have caused to be surveyed, laid out and platted into lots, blocks, streets, avenues and alleys, a tract of land lying and being situated in the County of Yellowstone, State of Montana, described as follows:— Beginning at a point on the South line of Section 3, Township 3 North, Range 27 East, N.P.M., 6600 feet West of the South-east corner of said section 3, and running thence North, 3100 feet; thence West, 3198 feet; thence, 5,33°17'W, 3708 feet to a point on the South line of said Section 3; thence, East 5232 feet to the point of beginning. This tract of land, as shown on the accompanying plat is to be known as the "TOWN OF HOLLAND"; and that all the land included in the Streets, Avenues, and Alleys, as shown on the said plat is hereby donated, granted and given to the public use forever.

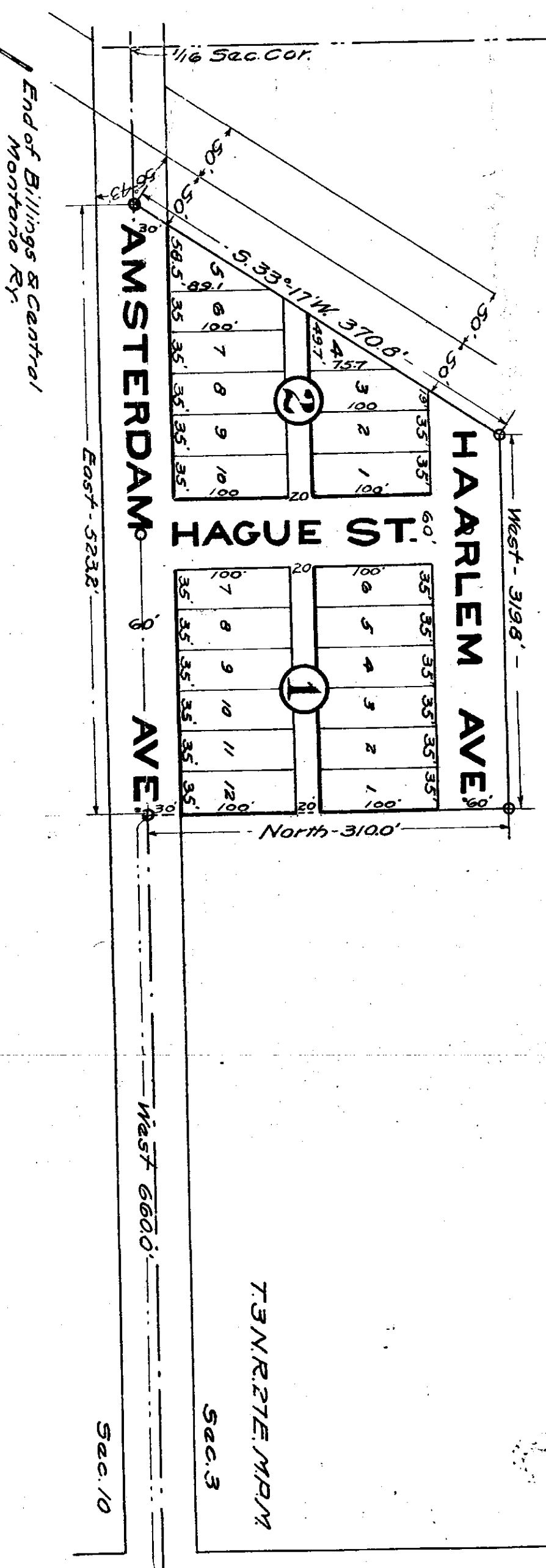
