- 1. Hosted by AMR. Introductions made.
- Montana Elks Association Doug Lentsch spoke about rural fire department grants that are available from their organization. Applications for this year's grants are open until Dec. 31, 2024. Information contained in the plan can be very useful for rural fire departments in applying for grants. The new Custer repeater in the Hysham Hills is ready but for its new antenna. Derek is still working on the results of our two fire chiefs meetings. There is an effort currently under way in the eastern part of the county to form an ambulance district. Not much else is known about the efforts.

AMR - staffing is currently good! Sheriff - staffing is up. Mentioned calls concerning water hauled for an animal hoarding situation, a shooting in Blue Creek and suicide at Pompey's Pillar. DNRC - Dustin has extended training requests by 3 days and deadline is Nov 15. Only 5 out of about 40 fire depts. (in the SLO) made requests. Looking for comments on staffed station program: complaints, concerns, suggestions, compliments. Send those to Jeff Brown. BLM - one engine in Tenn. Next year combining the helicopters from Lewistown and Miles City to Billings which may create 15-20 new jobs here. County Fire Chief - Mike Waters, the new commissioner will be at the next FC meeting in Jan. Mark Morse will take over as the new County Fire Chief.
